protect the head. In wet conditions, shoes should be waterproof and have good traction. Make sure that your cold weather gear does not restrict your movement or block your

eye-sight.

Be Aware

One of the biggest dangers from working in the cold can be the hardest to detect. Hypothermia happens when your body temperature drops below 95°F. Mild hypothermia can make you feel confused and you may not think anything is wrong until it is too late.

Being too cold can also cloud your judgment and cause you to make mistakes while you work.

Early symptoms of hypothermia include shivering, feeling tired, being clumsy, and being confused. As your body loses more heat, the shivering may stop, your skin may turn blue, the

pupils of your eye may expand, your pulse and breathing may slow, and you may pass out.

Be Ready for the Cold

If you have to work in the cold, always wear clothes that are right for the weather. Remember that you may not think it’s that cold, but your body could be stressed enough that you make poor decisions or react more slowly than normal. Pay attention to warning signs of hypothermia, frost bite, or other cold-weather injuries.

When workers do their jobs in the cold, they face many risks. Some cold weather dangers are obvious, but others are harder to see. Sometimes you might not even think it’s very cold, but a cold-weather injury can still harm you.

Be Prepared

Workers who must be out in the cold should wear warm clothing that is right for the weather. Wear several layers of loose clothing. Layering provides better insulation.

Gloves should protect the hands, and a hat and/or hood should pro-

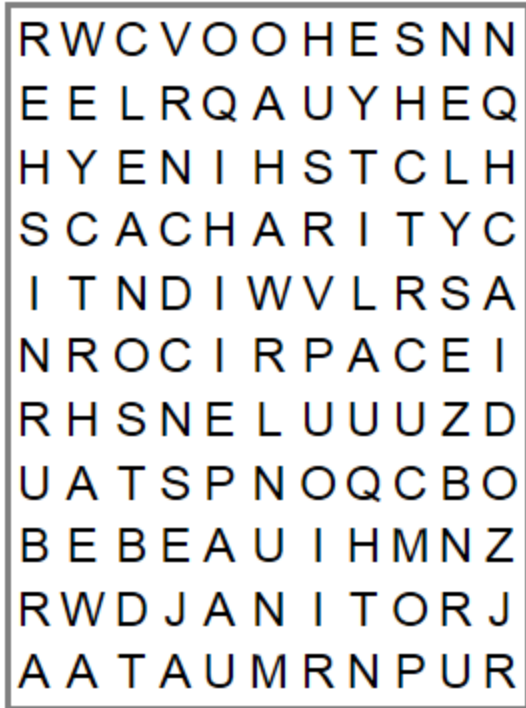
